THE ASTROBANK – HERITAGE PRIVATE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2017/2018

We are delighted to announce the winners of the two AstroBank – Heritage Private School Scholarships for the academic year 2017/2018.

The Year 12 Scholarship is awarded to the student who achieves the best combined overall academic results in IGCSE, GCSE, AS Level and A Level examinations taken at The Heritage Private School during Year 11, and the value of the Scholarship covers half of the student's Year 12 Heritage Private School fees. The Year 13 Scholarship is awarded to the student who achieves the best combined overall academic results in IGCSE, GCSE, AS Level and A Level examinations taken at The Heritage Private School during Year 12, and the value of the Scholarship covers half of the student's Year 13 Heritage Private School fees.

The best combined overall academic results are calculated using UMS scores. The UMS (Uniform Mark Scale) is the method used by examination boards to convert the marks attained in each examination unit and series into scores. Grades are then calculated using grade boundaries set at particular UMS scores. This process standardises the marking of papers between different examination boards, allowing a fair comparison between final grades achieved by students.

Year 12 Scholarship

Dimitris Karapanagiotis: for the best combined overall academic results in IGCSE, GCSE, AS Level and A Level examinations taken at The Heritage Private School during Year 11.

In Year 11 Dimitris achieved grade A* in eight IGCSE subjects and a grade A in one AS Level subject, giving him an average UMS score of 96.8% and making him the winner of the Year 12 Scholarship.

Year 13 Scholarship

Ivan Sokolovskiy: for the best combined overall academic results in IGCSE, GCSE, AS Level and A Level examinations taken at The Heritage Private School during Year 12.

In Year 12 Ivan achieved grade A in four subjects at GCE and International AS Level and grade A* in one subject at GCE A2 Level, giving him an average UMS score of 98.3% and making him the winner of the Year 13 Scholarship.
